Dear Friends,

It's not too late to join the course at St Teilo's on Tuesday evenings (see diary dates). It is being led by Clive and Gaynor Pritchard, Christians of wide experience of Christian churches in this country and overseas, and its aim is to enable us to recognise the gifts God has given us and see how they can best be used to serve him in the life of our churches and communities today.

It's sometimes said that there are two different models of church life – those of the cruise ship and the battleship. On the cruise ship a hard working crew serve those who are there simply to relax and enjoy everything they can from the experience. On the battleship everyone, from the cooks and engineers to the weapons officers, has a job to do and the ship cannot function properly unless each one plays their part.

Jesus made it clear in the parable of the talents (Matthew 25:14-30) that He expects us to use the gifts and abilities he has entrusted to us, and His language is forthright in describing the man who simply buried what he was given in the ground as a "wicked, lazy servant" (Mt 25:26).

The coming season of Lent reminds us that we are caught up in a spiritual battle. Despite the terrible things happening in the world, secular society seems largely oblivious to this, but those of us who are Christians need to be focussed and occupied in working for the Kingdom of God. We must see our church membership as our belonging to the crew of the battleship, and use our God given gifts and abilities to enable it to fulfill the tasks of mission and evangelism in the world which God has given us. The world around us may not think that it needs Jesus Christ but it does, and we must make Him known, as He's told us to do.
