We seem to be engaged in a never ending game of Whack-a-mole. As we succeed in damping down problems in one place, so new problems spring up elsewhere to replace them.


Christians know that there is only one person who can finally bring lasting peace, the One whom the Bible calls, "**Prince of Peace**" (Isaiah 9:6). He alone can deal with the root of all of our human problems, which is that we have become separated and alienated from the life for which we were created and fallen into slavery to sin from which we are totally unable to extricate ourselves.

The Bible promises us "**a new heaven and a new earth, the home of righteousness**" (2 Peter 3:13), but we will never be able to inhabit it unless we are utterly changed and transformed. We need forgiveness and we need to be recreated, and this is what the death and resurrection of Jesus makes possible for us (2 Corinthians 5:17). Here and now, in this world, we must receive His forgiveness and take what Jesus describes in the Sermon on the Mount as the narrow road which leads to life (Matthew 7:14).

We have become blind and deaf as a nation to what so many of earlier generations knew and understood. Please pray that God will do whatever is needed to turn us back to Him. As Habakkuk prayed in his day:

**LORD, I have heard of your fame;
I stand in awe of your deeds, O LORD.
Renew them in our day,
In our time make them known;
In wrath remember mercy.** (Habakkuk 3:2)
