Dear Friends,

It must be obvious to all of us that we need to begin growing again as churches.

For too long traditional churches and chapels have relied on those who fell away from church life in their younger adult years "returning to the fold" in middle age, but this no longer happens as it used to because most people now reaching their middle years have never been part of a church or chapel and feel no particular loyalty or allegiance to the Christian faith

In New Testament terms you might say that in many places the church today is like a fishing fleet which has forgotten how to fish, or an army which has forgotten how to fight and win. We cannot expect that our situation will improve unless we relearn those things which have lain neglected, for the most part, for many generations.

This autumn we will be looking at the letter which the apostle Paul wrote to the Christians in Rome, in which he lays out the essentials of the Gospel message which God had called him and led him to preach with such remarkable effect around the Roman world. If you look at the churches today which are growing then, for the most part, they are churches where members have a clear grasp of this teaching and a vision, therefore, for sharing it with the world around them.

Acts 2:42 tells us the first Christians "devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer."

These are the essentials for a healthy spiritual life and a healthy church life, and we cannot afford to neglect them. As we move into autumn can I therefore encourage you to be regular and frequent worshippers week by week in our church services, and also to think seriously about coming to the Tuesday evening meetings if they are not already a regular part of your Christian commitment.
