We will be inviting the **local community** to drop into church with their family during the week to follow a **Prayer Trail** and write a prayer and these **prayers will be presented at the 11 o'clock service on 1st June**. We will also be inviting them to visit the church website and send prayers and prayer requests.

From Monday to Friday there will be a daily rhythm of prayer with short services of communal said prayer in the Side Chapel at 10:30 am (not Wednesday as Communion Service), 1 pm and 4 pm. On Wednesday at 12:15 there will be a Soup Lunch.

On Saturday 31st from 9:15 (St Teilo's) to 12 o'clock we will join other Christians in a Prayer Relay held around various chapels and churches in town.

On **Sunday 1st** we will end the week with a **Prayer Walk around Llandeilo** after the 11 o'clock service, when we stop at all of the entry/exit points and pray God's blessing on our town. This is a gentle walk, with a number of stops, which starts and finishes at St Teilo's taking about two hours but you can bow out at any point.
